

Pilot Agreement

Data protection and disclosure of personal data

When pilots are registered, ETH Zurich collects medical data on the participating pilots in order to ensure that the inclusion criteria as stipulated by the rules (CYBATHLON Races & Rules) are met. ETH Zurich promises to treat the medical data of the pilots as confidential and to only allow authorised persons to access this information.

The MedCheck is conducted by neutral medical examiners appointed by the CYBATHLON organising committee. The appointed medical examiners, who may also work outside ETH, are obliged to treat the information provided confidentially.

The MedCheck data is stored on ETH servers, which are specially secured and set up for sensitive data, until after the CYBATHLON main event (CYBATHLON 2024) has taken place. ETH Zurich guarantees that the data is erased within 12 months after the CYBATHLON 2024 main event or will continue to be stored only in anonymised form. After the respective event has ended, the pilot may request the early erasure of their data at any time without providing a reason by sending a written communication to this effect to CYBATHLON.
